Southern Railway issued 3 inch lettering initials to identify road ownership. These initials were usually placed in the upper corner near the end of the car. For heavyweight cars, the lettering was imitation gold (yellow) paint and for lightweight cars the lettering was painted black. The above graphics is not to model scale, but can be sized to any scale if height & width ratio are maintained. I have provided separate scale drawings.
