Southern Railway Baggage Cars were initially lettered with Roman style lettering. In the 1940s SR issued block style alphabet for re-lettering. However, roman style lettering survived until the late 1940s or even the early 1950s as not all cars got repainted immediately. The block lettering was 5 inches in height and was painted with imitation gold (yellow) paint. The graphics illustrated above are not to model scale. However, the lettering can be resized to any scale as long as height & width ratio are maintained. I have provided scale drawing of this lettering.
