Southern Railway issued Block Alphabet & numerals for passenger cars in 1941 for use on the new lightweight stainless steel streamline cars operated on "The Southerner" and "The Tennessean". Block lettering and numerals were also used on rebuilt heavyweight cars in the 1940s. Numbers for lightweight cars were painted black and were 6 inches tall. Numbers for heavyweight cars were painted imitation gold (yellow) and were 5 inches tall. The numbers represented above are not to model scale but can be scaled up or down to any size as long as height and width dimensions are maintained. Separate scale drawings are provided.
