PULLMAN Letterboard was standard 7 inches in height. The lettering was an imitation gold (yellow) paint. In the early years through middle 1930s, the lettering may have been Gold Leaf. However, like most railroads, Gold Leaf was discontinued in favor of paint. In the 1940s and later, PULLMAN used Block lettering on some cars. The graphics depicted here are not to model scale, but can be resized to any scale as long as height to width ratio is maintained. I have drawings of the Pullman letterboard that are scaled for models.
