This 20 inch monogram (nose herald) was first used in the early 1940s on the EMD FT class freight diesels. This was the standard nose herald until the late 1940s, when Southern changed the lettering to "green". The lettering for the first circular herald was black on imitation gold background. This herald can also be seen on some steam locomitives on the cab next to the window. However, for steam locos, the lettering was imitation gold with no background.
