Southern Railway issued the roman style lettering in the late 1890s. The above graphics illustrate the numbers 0-9 which were used for both freight and passenger locomotives and tenders. The numbers were various sizes for tender lettering or locomotive lettering, but the dimensional ratio was maintained. Therefore the above graphics can be scaled up or down to any height as long as the dimensions are maintained. From the 1890s to middle 1930s, passenger locos were lettered with Gold Leaf, but, about 1935, was changed to imitation gold (yellow) paint for the remainder of the steam era.
