Southern Railway Nose Monogram for Diesel Hood Units and some E & F Units. This herald was adopted in the late 1960s for use on the black diesel hood units and was later used on diesel E-8s and FP-7s painted in the late green scheme. It can also be seen near the door of some streamlined passenger cars very late near the end of SR passenger service. The monogram was 20 inches in diameter. Initially, the lettering was green on a bronze gold background, but around 1979, the background was changed to dulux gold.
