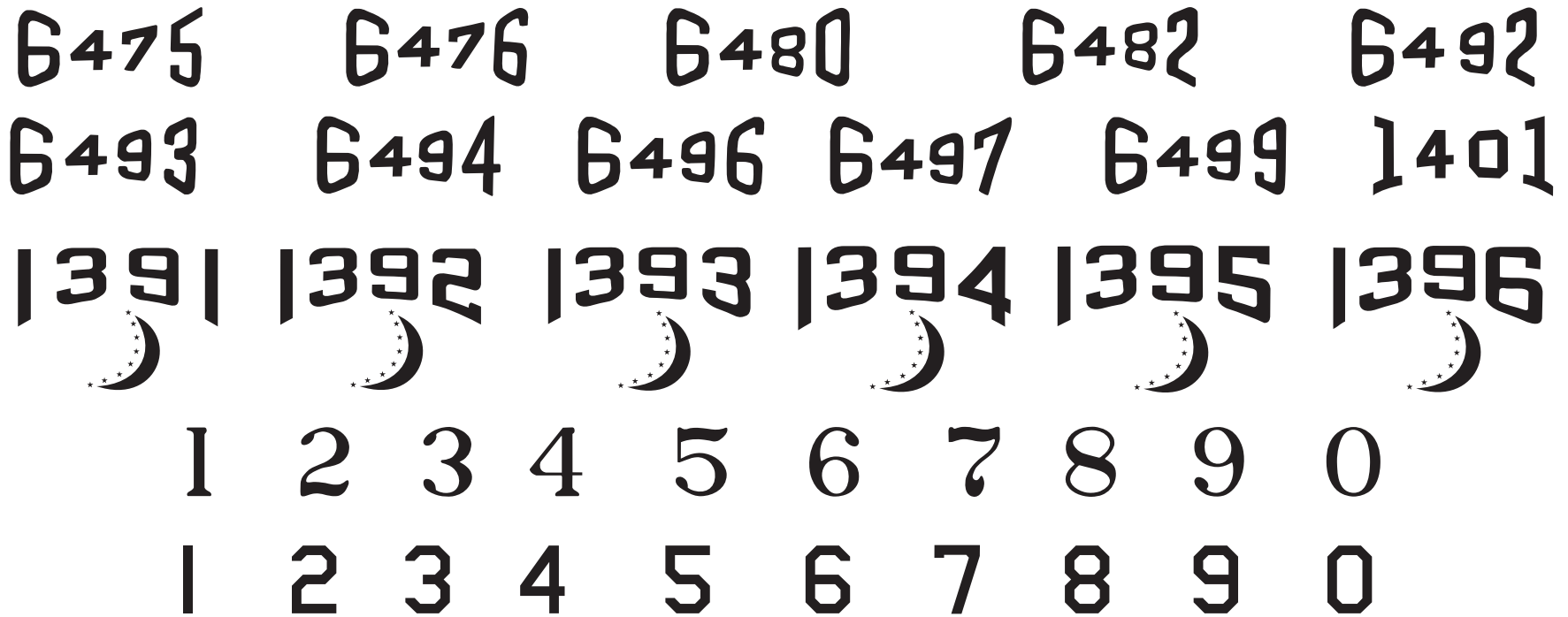

STEAM LOCOMOTIVE HEADLIGHT NUMBER PLATE - PASSENGER ENGINES

The above graphics are Southern Railway Passenger Engine Number Plates located under the headlight on the front of the smokebox. These number plates were mostly brass or bronze castings with raised letters. The 13XX numbers with the crescent moon and stars were used on the PS-4s that powered the SR Crescent Limited from the mid 1920s until the mid 1930s. It is not certain if these boards were replaced with normal boards after the CL was discontinued. The 64XX numbers were CNO&TP Engines. Generally, the numbers were 4.25 inches tall. The normal board was about 7.75" X 17" with the fancy boards being about 8.75" X 17". The usual color was gold on a red background, but gold on green or black background was also used.

These graphics are not to model scale, but can be resized to any scale as long as dimensions are maintained. I will provide the graphics in HO, S, N and O scale as DECAL artwork.
